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SPECIAL CONDITIONS

7. When it is in the best interest of the County construction aggregate (materials consisting of crushed stone, gravel, crushed gravel, pebbles, limestone, lime rock, shell rock and concrete) may be disposed of at any aggregate material recycler in Polk County who provides the service free of charge. An Aggregate Material Disposal Verification Form must accompany any invoice submitted to the County for payment, for each load of aggregate material disposed of, signed by the recycler. A digital picture must also be submitted for each load of aggregate material disposed of as part of verification. The County will only reimburse for aggregate material disposed of at the North Central Land Fill. The Vendor is still responsible for labor and transportation to any aggregate material recycler.
