Target Performance Goals by Provider

- Full Time Physician: 4,200 per year (min 19 day)
- Full Time OB/GYN: 4,000 per year (min 18 day)
- Full Time Pediatrician: 4,200 per year (min 19 day)
- Full Time ARNP: 3,100 per year (min 14 day)
- Full Time Dentist: 3,000 per year (min 14 day)
- Full Time Hygienist: 2,080 per year (min 8 day)

Daily Schedule Notables

- Patient schedule allows for a patient every 15 minutes
- New patient appointment = 30 minutes
- Follow up patients = 15 minutes
- Procedures = 30 minutes
- Walk-In appointments throughout the day as the schedule allows and as the severity of the nurse triage identifies
