# CRIMINAL JUSTICE MENTAL HEALTH SUBSTANCE ABUSE REINVESTMENT GRANT OPPORTUNITY



- CJMHSA grant was created by the Florida Legislature in 2007; recurs every 3 years
- Provide funding to counties to plan, implement, or expand initiatives that increase public safety, avert increased spending on criminal and juvenile justice systems, and improve the accessibility and effectiveness of treatment services for people who have a mental illness, substance abuse disorders, or co-occurring mental health and substance abuse disorders, who are in, or at risk of entering, the criminal or juvenile justice systems
- Polk County received one of the first CHMHSAs implementation grant awards in 2007



# 2016 OPPORTUNITY

- Expansion Grant opportunity
- Letter of Intent to apply was submitted
- Statewide 33 Letters of Intent were submitted
- Maximum award: \$400,000 yr. over 3 years
- Cash match required \$120,000:

\$60,000 year 3
