
The Story of Angels Care Center

Angels Care Center began in March 2011, as a vision inspired by God, to help and care for people in the Eloise area. We started with a facility location and base support from St. John's United Methodist Church. We have served the local residents for 5 years. We provide diagnostic care, follow up and treatments.

We are strictly a primary clinic. One night a month is designated for diabetics, a night for dermatology needs and every Tuesday night is for primary care. Diabetic teaching and supplies

are provided along with services from a volunteer nutritionist to address dietary concerns.

Patients that need services not provided by Angels Care Center are referred to other facilities including "We Care" and the Polk County Health Department.



Who Qualifies for Services


Primary care is provided by volunteer medical personnel and assistants.

Who qualifies for services:

- Polk County residents
- Below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- Not eligible for medical care through Medicaid, Medicare or private insurance.
- Picture ID required, with Polk County address
- Bring current medications and recent hospital records, if applicable

Excludes (areas we do not treat patients at this facility):

- Obstetrics
- Gynecology



1 Triage Room


(We have 3 total triage rooms)





- ❖ Established free medical clinic March 22, 2011 for Polk County / Eloise Community
- ❖ Annually average served approximately 1230 patients
- ❖ Annual average patient encounters 5170
- ❖ Services provided for patients:
 - Primary Care Clinic
 - Diabetic Clinic
 - Dermatology Clinic
 - Diagnostic testing services
- Partnership with Winter Haven Hospital BayCare


