ATV PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All Riding is at your own risk.
2. No Alcohol or illegal drugs on County Property.
3. Protect the environment. No littering, dumping of fuels, motor oils or other related materials.
4. No pets allowed.
5. Everyone that enters the park must register at the main gate and fill out the appropriate paperwork and pay admission prior to riding.
6. Entry to property is authorized only during posted hours of operation. A valid daily receipt must be in the vehicle operator's possession at all times.
7. Everyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult and paperwork must be completed by legal parent or guardian. All riders under the age of 12 must be supervised by parent or guardian.
8. Riders 16 and under must show proof of successful completion of a state recognized and mandated rider safety course.
9. All vehicles must be registered per federal, state and local statutes.
10. All vehicles must meet federal, state and local requirements (noise, pollution and safety).
11. Helmets and safety equipment are required while vehicle is in motion.
12. Speed limit is 15 MPH on all roads.
13. Travel only on marked trails or in areas designated for riding. Do not blaze new trails.
14. Riding double is not allowed unless the vehicle was designed by the manufacturer for additional passengers.
15. Trails are ridden in one direction only.
16. Riders must come to a complete stop at all intersections.
17. No three wheelers, jeeps or sand rails. Four wheelers, side by sides and dirt bikes only.
18. All riders must stay inside the boundary of the park.
19. Park Management reserves the right to expel any rider not following the rules or operating a vehicle in an unsafe manner.
