

Services include:

Primary Medical Care, Family Planning, Gynecology, Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Internal Medicine, Dental, Diagnostic Lab, Diagnostic X-ray, Pharmacy, Hearing Screening, Vision Screening, Mental Health Services, HIV Testing and Immunizations.

What is the cost for a visit?

The minimum fee is \$25. Our health centers serve all who seek our care regardless of ability to pay. Our centers rely on subsidies from federal, state and local governments to help cover the cost of services furnished to the uninsured. No individual or family is turned away or denied medical care because of income.

Items to bring to your first visit:

- Photo Identification
- Health insurance card(s)
- Social Security card
- Proof of income for sliding fee schedule discount
- Medical or dental history
- Medical records (especially) if recent hospital admission or Emergency Room visit
- List of medications currently taking and/or bottles of medication
- Foster parent or grandparent: Guardian or custody papers showing custody of child required
- Adult guardian: Power of Attorney required

Appointments vs. Walk-ins

Appointments are preferred but are not necessary for urgent medical needs. If you would like to be seen without an appointment, please call or stop by the center. Often, you can be worked in between scheduled appointments with the first provider available. Patients with appointments will be seen first, except in situations of medical urgency.
