

Windows 8 Users

Step 1. Download Chrome Browser from www.google.com

Step 2. Disable User Account Control (UAC) Settings. See instructions below. **Before proceeding to Step 3, you will need to restart your PC after lowering the UAC settings.**

Disable UAC with Windows 8 Search

- Access the Windows 8 Start Screen by hitting the Windows Key, then type *user account control settings* in the search text field.
- Click on the search results in the Settings heading, then double-click on the **Change user account control settings** icon on the left side of the screen.
- Next, refer back to Figure 6 (shown above) and the steps listed there.




Figure Using Windows 8 search to access the UAC settings screen.





Figure Setting UAC to 'Never Notify' on the 'User Account Settings' screen.

Step 3 Using the Chrome Browser shortcut on your desktop go to eplans.polk-county.net/ProjectDox to Log into Eplan

Click on a Project/Permit number to enter into the project/permit

Click on the Application Folder (example shown in red below)
