

# Uninsured? Limited Income? Take a look at the Polk HealthCare Plan

The Polk HealthCare Plan (PHP) is for those who are caught in the gap between not qualifying for Medicaid or Medicare, and not being able to afford marketplace insurance.

Because the plan is not insurance, participants have no annual deductibles and no claim forms. Most services require a low copayment, which is collected by the provider.

The plan is funded by the countywide half-cent indigent health care sales surtax.



## Quick ✓ Facts

### Eligibility

- **Must be a current, full-time resident of Polk County**
- **No health insurance**
- **Not eligible for Medicaid, Medicare or other health insurance**
- **Limited household income**
- **Must provide photo ID; Social Security card; proof of residence, income and household expenses**
- **You must be either a citizen of the U.S. or a lawfully admitted immigrant; and, have a Social Security card**
- **Eligibility is generally for one year and can be renewed**
- **Eligibility takes into consideration household size, income and assets**

### What services are available?

Medical services provided by the Polk HealthCare Plan are coordinated through a participating Primary Care Doctor and may include:

- **Doctor visits and checkups**
- **In-patient services**
- **Emergency room care**
- **Prescription medications**
- **Medical tests**

Other than a small copay when you go to the doctor or get a prescription filled, there is no cost to you; no enrollment fees and no monthly fees.
