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Financial Assistance Program

To qualify for the financial assistance program, please provide one of the following at time of registration:

- Current tax documents stating filed income and number of claimed dependents. Financial eligibility will be based on family size and gross income. Please see chart below for income limits. **We do not accept W2 forms.**
- Current **letter** of eligibility for Food Stamps or Medicaid eligibility from the Florida Department of Children and Families
- A foster parent **letter** from the court system listing the child's name

Session placement is only confirmed with payment. Parents must pay full price if the proper documentation is not presented at the time of registration.

- \$ 47.50 each additional child
