BIDS 23-640 OVERGROWTH AND SMALL LOT CLEARING ADDENDUM #2

Question 1: Is there a way to look at these lots in person before we submit our bid?

Answer: No, the sample packets included in addendum 1 are for that purpose.

Question 2: If the debris is less than 1 ton, do we still get the \$400 per ton fee paid?

Answer: No, the rate is prorated.

EXAMPLE: $\$.35 \text{ ton} \times \$400 = \$140 + \$10.50 \text{ dump ticket} + \$100 \text{ mobilization fee} = \$250.50 \text{ total for this job.}$

Question 3: Who pays for the Sheriff's Deputy & dump fees?

Answer: Code Enforcement pays for the Deputy. Dump tickets are paid by the vendor but reimbursed when Codes pays the invoice. (Submit your tickets in your invoice packet).

Question 4: If the property is less than 1 acre, how do we get paid? (ex: if it is minimum 1 acre paid, and say the lot is a 0.25 acre, do we get paid 25% of the acre price or the full acre price?)

Answer: Formula based on your example: $\$.25 \text{ acre} \times \text{new bid rate} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} + \$100 \text{ mobilization fee} = \text{total for the job.}$

Example based on our current bid rate it would be:

Under 36" $.25\text{-acre} \times \$600 = 150 + \$100 \text{ mobilization fee} = \$250 \text{ total for the job}$
