Question 1: Is there a way to look at these lots in person before we submit our bid? Answer: No, the sample packets included in addendum 1 are for that purpose. Question 2: If the debris is less than 1 ton, do we still get the \$400 per ton fee paid? Answer: No, the rate is prorated. EXAMPLE: \$.35 ton x \$400= \$140 + \$10.50 dump ticket + \$100 mobilization fee= \$250.50 total for this job. Question 3: Who pays for the Sheriff's Deputy & dump fees? Answer: Code Enforcement pays for the Deputy. Dump tickets are paid by the vendor but reimbursed when Codes pays the invoice. (Submit your tickets in your invoice packet). If the property is less than 1 acre, how do we get paid? (ex: if it is minimum 1 acre Question 4: paid, and say the lot is a 0.25 acre, do we get paid 25% of the acre price or the full acre price?) Answer: Formula based on your example: \$.25 acre x new bid rate = +\$100 mobilization fee= total for the job. Example based on our current bid rate it would be:
